

Synology releases 3 storage packages for its network-attached storage (NAS) products-- Drive, Office and Moments, enabling users to store, backup and synchronise files while ensuring privacy and security.



Moments allows users to backup photos from PCs and smartphones to a Synology NAS. It uses deep-learning analytics to automatically identify people, places and objects in photos, before sorting in appropriate albums. Meanwhile Drive is a revamp of the Cloud Station Suite file syncing software. It promises simplified data management on Synology NAS, allowing data syncing across multiple devices and easier office collaboration.

Also included in Drive My Drive for personal storage, a Team Folder for team collaboration, Desktop Client for local synchronisation, integration with Office and universal search. The final offering is Office, the Synology browser-based collaborative editor. It provides means for users to create, share and simultaneously work on documents, spreadsheets and slides, with all collaborative tools managed on Drive.
