

A10 Networks launches ACOS 4.0 and A10 Harmony, an architecture the company says is the foundation of a rapid services integration platform for enterprises, cloud and service provider networks.



A10 Harmony allows developers to integrate intelligent application networking services via high-performance A10 Thunder Series Application Delivery Controllers (ADC). Other enhancements include Secure Interconnect IPsec VPN, SSL Insight, Application Access Management (AAM) and Web Application Firewall (WAF).

The architecture leverages the ACOS platform with open standards, with the A10 Harmony Policy Engine providing intelligence, efficiency and scale, while expanded aXAPI SDK and RESTful APIs enable effective provisioning, analytics telemetry and comprehensive security.

Another ACOS 4.0 addition is Secure Cloud Interconnect with hyper-scale performance IPsec VPN and enhanced SSL Insight, WAF and AAM features.

"ACOS 4.0 is our most significant release since the launch of the 64-bit version of ACOS," A10 Networks says. "ACOS 4.0 with A10 Harmony ushers in a new era of SDN and cloud computing-- it lays the foundation for next-generation SDN ADC and paves the way for programmable intelligent application and security services."
