Canadian managed security services provider Herjavec Group buys British security vendor Sysec for an unspecified sum, part of a 3-year \$250 million expansion plan into European markets.

Following acquisition the Sysec Reading, UK offices will serve as Herjavec Group's European HQ. The company will be rebranded as Herjavec Group, and expand its product and service offerings throughout European markets. Sysec managing director Chris Pikes remains on board to lead the European expansion.

As part of its "follow-the-sun" technical support structure Herjavec Group is also building a security operations centre in London to complement its existing centers in Toronto and Las Vegas.
