Post-acquisition the Agix brand and employees will be folded in the EET Europarts French business.

The Danish distributor has been keeping busy with the acquisitions this year-- last month saw it buy Spanish cabling company Import Cable, its 2nd S. European acquisition of 2016. And it insists to continue buying other companies at such a rate in the near future, something it describes as "an important part of our strategy."
