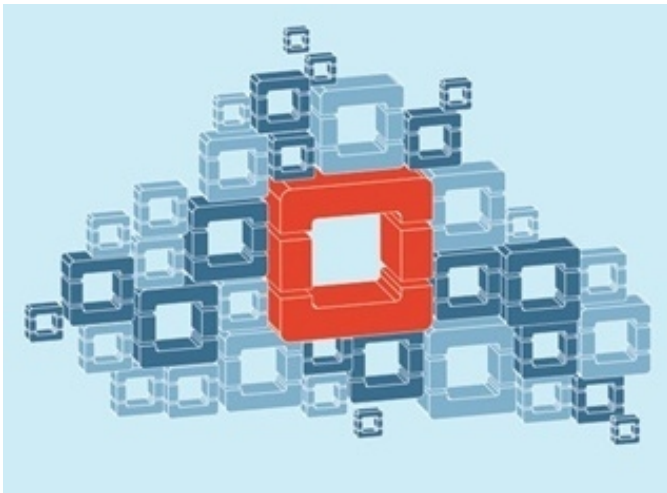


Rackspace Puts OpenStack on Private Cloud
