

Huawei presents a European Research Institute (ERI) in Leuven, Belgium, which the company says will strengthen its ongoing partnership with European industry as well as help in achieving Digital Agenda targets.



The ERI will manage the company's 18 R&D sites across the company, as well as host 5G telecom research with European partners. Leading the institution is Huawei European R&D, standardisation and technical cooperation activity boss Dr. Zhou Hong.
