

Infoxia Phone Gets Skyped

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The Invoxia NVX 610 phone gets an update in the shape of Skype compatibility, in addition to Vivo Acoustic technology in handsfree mode.



The NVX 610 carries an ARM Cortex A8 processor and uses iOS devices (via free app) as a touch-based control interface.

It features x8 wide-bandwidth speakers and x8 digital microphones-- with the capacity to perform virtual remote speaker placement in conference mode and automatic local speaker localisation. Meanwhile Vivo Acoustic technology cancels echoes and background noise.

It also unifies professional and mobile contacts in the same directory, and handles both mobile and landline incoming calls.

Ideal for office environments, the NVX 620 comes with x3 magnetic handset holders for a variety of placement options.

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
