The VuScape is a video wall controller aimed at control rooms, collaboration rooms and corporate signage. It claims collaboration and KVM support, in addition to video wall control functionality. With VuScape, users can control and distribute all content sources to any display on the network. The latest functionality in the control software, VuWall2, features automation enhancements including a carousel for IP streams, colour detection, TLS security, VMS plug-ins and full KVM support of IP sources.

VuWall will also debut the 15-inch ControlVu touchpanel, alongside a 10-inch model. The series features the company's web-based control panel designer. Another offering at ISE 2020 involves the security capabilities available within the TRx 2.5 centralised management solution for configuring and operating multiple video walls, multiviewers, encoders and decoders. TRx claims to simplify the deployment of complex AV-over-IP networks, with the latest version adding Transport Layer Security (TLS) between the TRx GUI and TRx Server, improved user rights management and additional KVM modes.
