

NEC Presents Ultra-Wide MultiSync EX341R

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NEC Display Solutions announces the MultiSync EX341R-- a 34-inch curved monitor with a 21:9 aspect ratio designed to provide an "immersive" desktop experience.



Aimed mainly at commercial clients, the EX341R features a 3440 x 1440 resolution SVA panel with an 1800R curvature and bezels just 1.55mm thin on 3 sides. It also carries ControlSync technology to simplify multi-monitor configurations when combined with DisplayPort daisy-chain functionality, as well as a picture-by-picture mode to replace existing monitors.

Another interesting addition is a human presence sensor able to turn the display off when the user leaves the workstation. Low Blue Light Content and Flicker-Free certification from TÜV Rheinland promise to reduce eye strain, while SpectraViewII software (available either separately or as a bundle) ensures uniform and accurate colours.

Connectivity comes through x2 HDMI, x4 USB 3.0 and DisplayPort 1.2 input/output ports. The USB hub features DisplaySync Pro technology to allow users to control 2 PCs with 1 keyboard and 1 mouse by using the display to switch between computers.

"Our new MultiSync EX341R curved display delivers cutting edge technology with one of the tightest curvatures in the market for business, finance, command & control users, and others who need an immersive environment to do their jobs," the company says. "The ultra-wide workspace is crucial for power users who work in multiple spreadsheets or web development, and the factory colour calibration is ideal for video and online photo editors."

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
